Format for the Ministerial Roundtables**Basic structure**

- There will be two rounds of interventions in response to the topics during the roundtables, and each participant is invited to intervene during either one or both rounds.
- Each participant is kindly asked to limit their interventions to 3-5 minutes. The Chair nominates speakers so that participants wishing to make interventions can do so at least once.

- All Ministers, Vice Ministers, Heads of Delegations and representatives of the Ukrainian companies will be seated together around a table in White Hall. All other delegates will be seated in the Tapestry Room, with live coverage from the White Room. The Tapestry Hall is accessed through a door in the White Hall.
